## A PCC Mission Moment for December 2

World Soil Day (Dec. 5)



Soil gives life and supports livelihoods around the world. In Badin, Pakistan, **Rabia's life depends on access to rich, fertile soil** - she needs it to grow the crops she sells each week at the market. But an especially dry summer has led to severe **water shortages in her village. Rabia's soil** was too arid to yield the produce she needs. With support from PWS&D and

Canadian Foodgrains Bank, Rabia has learned to adopt agricultural practices that use less water. She also received seeds to grow crops that can survive **extended dry periods. "This is highly beneficial for farmers like me, who reside in water-scarce areas," shares Rabia.**
