FIRE SAFETY DRILL SUNDAY WORSHIP GATHERING MAY 26

Please note the following instructions:

WHEN THE FIRE ALARM RINGS:

1. Listen to Instructions. The Minister is in charge.
2. Walk at once to the nearest EXIT, as indicated on the Evacuation Route Plan.
3. Assist anyone who needs help.
4. Walk one or two abreast. DO NOT PUSH OR RUN.
5. Do not stop for coats unless you have medical reasons for warm clothing.
6. Upon reaching outside, move well away from the building and gather at the area designated by the Minister (the Cemetery).
7. If the ALARM STOPS, continue OUT of the building. Only the Fire Department may authorize re-entry.

Envisioning malaria-free communities



In Thimalala village in Malawi, Jimmy Gondwe was not sleeping well. He was concerned about the mosquitoes inside his home, fearing they carried the deadly malaria virus. While malaria rates have gone down in Malawi, it remains a significant health challenge, especially among pregnant women and children. Malaria-carrying mosquitoes mostly bite at night, with more than 80 per cent of transmission occurring indoors. To help ensure more households stay healthy and malaria-free, a Presbyterian World Service & Development project is helping to safely treat homes with insecticide. Jimmy reports that since the project, he feels safer inside his home - a now mosquito-free environment. **"I am grateful for the support," Jimmy said.**
